AN ACT Relating to Taxation of Motor Vehicles.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 12, § 98, amended. Section 98 of chapter 12 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

‘Sec. 98. Collector in adjacent town or city to make collection in unincorporated places. The collector of taxes of any adjacent town or the city treasurer of any adjacent city shall receive the excise tax and issue receipt prescribed therefor under this chapter to persons residing in unorganized places in any county. ~~Such fees shall be for the use of the town in which such tax is paid.~~ The collector shall be allowed a fee of 15c for each tax receipt issued, and the remainder shall be remitted monthly to the county treasurer to be added to the road repair tax fund for the unorganized township in which the taxpayer resides.’
