RESOLVE, in Favor of J. E. White, of Columbia.

J. E. White, of Columbia; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$500 be paid to J. E. White, of Columbia, for extra labor and materials furnished on a contract job on state highway "N," federal aid project 99, section D, in Columbia Falls, this amount to be a settlement in full for all claims against the state of Maine; said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.
