STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, to Reimburse the Town of Bethel for the Fighting of Fire in Unorganized Township of Albany.

Town of Bethel, reimbursed. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, in favor of the town of Bethel, the sum of \$150 as a full and final settlement against the state for expenses and use of equipment in the fighting of fire in the unorganized township of Albany; said sum to be paid from the funds of the forestry department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

This fire occurred in the woods in the vicinity of Hunt's Corner. The selectmen of Bethel were requested by Roy Wardwell, agent of the township, to aid in extinguishing the fire.
