#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Alfred Lausier, of Frenchville.

Mrs. Alfred Lausier, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$150 as a settlement in full for all damage caused to her property by the raising of the grade of the road by the state highway commission; said sum to be paid from the general highway funds.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

In 1935, a piece of road was built, on state highway No. 1, in the town of Frenchville. Where the road goes by Mrs. Lausier's property, the grade was raised so that the level of the road is higher than the cellar of the house, situated on mentioned property, and every spring the drainage from the road fills the cellar with water, and most of the summer.
