S T A T E O F M A I N E

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Alvah E. Spear, of Warren.

Alvah E. Spear; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$197.86, to be paid to Alvah E. Spear, of Warren, to compensate him in full for all claims against the state for damages done to his house by Edward Whalen, a paroled convict from the state prison; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Whalen drove an automobile against the house of Mr. Spear on December 10, 1938. The damage is estimated as follows:

Basement wall	\$150.00
House	40.00
Plumbing	7.86

The basement wall was broken and cracked on the northerly end and westerly side. The house was badly twisted and door frames sprung. The western side of the house was pushed 2 inches off the foundation. The house is located about 200 feet south of junction of state highway No. 1 and route 220 at South Warren.
