RESOLVE, in Favor of William A. Moran, of Bangor.

William A. Moran; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$40.17 to be paid to William A. Moran, of Bangor, as a full and final settlement against the state for damage to his lumber camps by bear; said sum to be paid from the funds of the department of inland fisheries and game.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

These camps were known as Camp No. 1, Camp No. 2 and Thibodeau Camp located in T8 R6, T9 R8 and T9 R7.
