#### STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of Charleston.

Town of Charleston, compensated. Resolved: That the Farm Lands Loan Commission of Maine be, and hereby is, authorized to pay to the town of Charleston the sum of \$908.07 to reimburse said town for taxes not paid to such town since 1931, and the additional sum of \$200 to reimburse said town for cost of conveyance of children to school.

# STATEMENT OF FACTS

Since 1931, property was taken over by the Farm Lands Loan Commission of Maine in the town of Charleston and thus removed from local taxation. The taxes on said property would have amounted to \$908.07. During this time, the town of Charleston has had to convey children from this property to school, under the law, at an extra expense as no other children are located in that territory.
