# STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

#### RESOLVE, in Favor of Mrs. Abbie Libby Towle, of Newfield and Oxbow.

Mrs. Towle; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$75 to be paid to Mrs. Abbie Libby Towle, of New-field and Oxbow, as a full and final settlement against the state for damage to her sporting camps by bear; said sum to be paid from the funds of the inland fisheries and game department.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

These camps are located at the headwaters of the Aroostook river, and the damage occurred in the late fall of 1937 and the early spring of 1938.
