STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Travel Expense of State Employees.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. Travel expense of state employees. Each head of a state department or commission and subordinates thereof, and employees thereof, shall be allowed reasonable expenses incurred in the performance of their official duties, provided, however, that such expenses shall not include expenses for travel between his place of residence and his official office or board and lodging in the city or town where such office is located.
- Sec. 2. Repealing clause. All acts or parts of acts inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed or amended to conform with the provisions hereof.
