**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE**

**AN ACT to Authorize the Construction of a Bridge on Square Pond in
Shapleigh.**

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

Building of bridge on Square pond, authorized. Edwin E. Bond and Ruth W. Bond of Waterville, their assigns, executors and heirs, are hereby authorized and empowered to construct and maintain a bridge between Blueberry Island, so-called, located in Square pond, or Pleasant pond, so-called, in the town of Shapleigh in York county, from the southeasterly point of said island to property owned or controlled by them located on the southeasterly shore of said pond. Provided, however, that construction shall be started within a period of 5 years from the effective date of this act.
