**RESOLVE, Creating a Recess Committee to Consider Using the Facilities of the Eastern State Normal School for Other Educational Purposes.**

**Recess committee on Eastern State Normal School, created. Resolved:** That there be, and hereby is, created a legislative recess committee to consist of 1 member of the senate and 2 members of the house of representatives to be appointed by the president of the senate and the speaker of the house with the advice and consent of the council, which committee shall be known as the "Committee on the Eastern State Normal School." Said committee shall meet as soon as convenient after appointment and organize by electing a chairman and secretary.

Said committee shall investigate and consider the possibilities of using the plant at the Eastern State Normal School at Castine for desirable purposes of education of youth other than the training of teachers, said committee to report its recommendations to the 90th legislature.

Members of said committee shall receive their actual expenses only, which may be incurred in the discharge of their duties as members thereof, said expenses to be approved by the governor and council. Such expenses shall not exceed, however, the sum of \$100.
