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**AN ACT to Amend the Charter of the Lubec Water Company.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Sec. 1. P. & S. L., 1901, c. 489, § 8, amended.** Section 8 of chapter 489 of the private and special laws of 1901, as amended, is hereby further amended by adding at the end thereof the following :

**‘Said corporation hereby is authorized to transmit electric current developed by said corporation for sale to the New Brunswick Electric Power Commission to a capacity not in excess of 100 kilowatts for use on the Island of Campobello only in the Province of New Brunswick.’**

**Sec. 2. Approval of public utilities commission.** All contracts for the sale of electricity as provided in section 1 hereof shall be subject to the approval of the public utilities commission.

**Sec. 3. Referendum.** This act shall take effect for the purpose of its submission to the legal voters of the town of Lubec for their acceptance or rejection as provided by law, but it shall not take further effect until accepted by the legal voters of that town at any special or regular town meeting called for that purpose, an appropriate article being inserted in the warrant for such meeting. If a majority of the legal voters present and

voting shall favor accepting this act, it shall become effective on the date of such vote. The town clerk shall file a certificate of such vote with the secretary of state.
