IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE.

AN ACT Naming the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. The Deer Isle-Sedgwick bridge. The bridge across Eggemoggin Reach, between the towns of Deer Isle and Sedgwick, is hereby designated and shall be forever known as "The Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge."
- Sec. 2. Bronze tablets to be erected. Before completion date of said bridge, the trustees of the Deer Isle-Sedgwick Bridge District, shall cause to be erected at each approach to said bridge, a bronze tablet, not less than 24" x 24" in size, and on which tablet shall be inscribed the following words: "This Bridge dedicated to the honor and memory of Frank McGuire whose untiring and unselfish devotion transformed a vision into a utility that will serve forever."
