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**AN ACT Relating to Powers of the County Commissioners.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 92, additional.** Chapter 92 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof a new section to be numbered 28, and to read as follows:

‘Sec. 28. Powers of county commissioners. The county commissioners of the several counties in the state may, without obtaining the consent of their respective counties, appropriate any sum, not exceeding  $\frac{1}{4}$  of 1 mill on \$1, based on the valuation of the preceding year, to be expended and used for advertising the natural resources, advantages, and attractions of the state, or said county.’
