RESOLVE, Concerning the Practice of Podiatry.

Fred H. Lowell permitted to file application for practice of podiatry.
Resolved: That the board of podiatry be, and hereby is, authorized and directed to receive the application of Fred H. Lowell of Bangor, Maine to practice podiatry under the provisions of chapter 140 of the public laws of 1933; provided, however, that the said Lowell shall furnish satisfactory proof to the said board that he had been engaged in the practice of podiatry a sufficient time to satisfy the requirements of said chapter 140.
