AN ACT Relative to the Use of Buckshot in Hunting Deer.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 38, § 47-A, additional. Chapter 38 of the revised statutes, as revised, is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 47-A and to read as follows:

‘Sec. 47-A. Use of buckshot in hunting deer prohibited. It shall be unlawful for any person to use buckshot, or shot of any size, in the hunting of deer.’
