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**RESOLVE, Permitting Examination of Alden Ulmer and Arthur Andrews  
by Embalming Board.**

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**Embalming board directed to give special examination. Resolved:** That the embalming board is hereby authorized and directed to give a theoretical examination to Alden Ulmer of Rockland, and Arthur Andrews of Rockport, to test their practical ability to practice the profession of embalming, and their knowledge of the embalming laws. In case either or both pass the said examination, they shall be entitled to practice embalming in the state, upon the payment of the usual license fee required of licensed embalmers.
