STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Regulating the Sale of Malt.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Licenses for the sale of malt and malt syrup. Malt or malt syrup shall not be sold except for bakery and industrial purposes by any person, firm or corporation.

Any person selling malt or malt syrup except for bakery and industrial purposes shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$500 or by imprisonment for less than one year.
