# STATE OF MAINE

#### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

#### RESOLVE, for Screening Outlet of Bog Lake in the Town of Northfield.

**Bog lake in Northfield; screening of. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to screen the outlet of Bog lake, in the town of Northfield, county of Washington; provided, however, that said screen shall not be erected at the outlet of Bog lake until some responsible corporation, or incorporated fish and game club, or the town in which the outlet of the pond to be screened is situated, or some other town in the county in which said waters are situated, shall have, in legal town meeting, and having an article in the warrant for said town meeting for that purpose, by vote of record, vote to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of water through the same.
