IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED

AN ACT Relating to Child Welfare.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 1, additional. Chapter 1 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 240-A, and to read as follows:

‘Sec. 240-A. Transfer of funds for aid to dependent children. Any funds appropriated to carry out the provisions of sections 234 to 240 of this chapter, as amended, may be allotted for aid to dependent children under the supervision of the department of health and welfare, provided, however, that no such transfer of funds shall be made which shall operate to the disadvantage of those dependents of veterans enumerated in section 235 as amended by chapter 215 of the public laws of 1937, not eligible for assistance under the provisions of chapter 177 of the public laws of 1937. Authority is hereby given to the said department to administer said funds according to the provisions of chapter 177 of the public laws of 1937.’
