RESOLVE, Appropriating Money for Study and Control of the Fruit or Blueberry Fly in Maine.

Resolves 1925, c. 17, amended. Chapter 17 of the resolves of 1925 is hereby repealed and the following enacted in place thereof:

Appropriation for blueberry fly control. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$5000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1940, and \$3000 for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941, to be expended under the direction of the commissioner of agriculture in repelling, destroying and mitigating the ravages of, and in preventing the spread and distribution of, the fruit fly infesting blueberries grown in the state of Maine, provided that any balance of the sum above appropriated for the fiscal year ending June 30, 1940, which may remain unexpended at the end of the said period shall be available for expenditure during the fiscal year ending June 30, 1941, and that any unexpended balance at the end of June 30, 1941 lapse into the general fund.
