STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, Providing for a State Pension for Artell Cookson, of Newcastle.

Artell Cookson; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$7 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Artell Cookson, of Newcastle, to be paid quarterly from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents, to R. L. Hodgkins, of Newcastle, to be expended by him for the benefit of said Artell Cookson. The said Hodgkins shall make a quarterly accounting to the department of health and welfare. Said pension shall begin July I, 1939, and shall continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Artell Cookson, of Newcastle, is the son of Lorenzo Cookson who enlisted January 18, 1864 and received an honorable discharge on account of disability on June 10, 1865.

Artell Cookson is without funds and has no means of support.
