STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Lighting Mount Desert Bridge.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Sec. 1. Lights to be maintained. The towns of Bar Harbor, Southwest Harbor, Mount Desert, Trenton and Tremont, assisted by the county of Hancock, are hereby authorized to maintain a proper lighting system on Mount Desert bridge, so-called. The cost of lighting said bridge shall be borne by the county and towns as follows: The county of Hancock shall pay \$100 annually, and each of the said towns shall pay the balance of said annual costs to be apportioned among the said towns in accordance with their respective valuations as fixed by the state tax assessor.

Sec. 2. County commissioners authorized to assess tax. The amount so to be paid by each of said towns shall be computed and fixed by the county commissioners of said county, and said several amounts shall be added to, included in, and become and be a part of the county tax annually assessed against said towns.

Sec. 3. Authority to raise and appropriate money. The said towns hereby are authorized to raise by taxation and appropriate such sums of money as are needed for the accomplishment of the purpose mentioned in section I hereof.
