**IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED
THIRTY-NINE**

**RESOLVE, in Favor of Robert E. Wright, of Rock City, Delmar,
New York.**

Robert E. Wright, compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$1,000.00 to be paid to Robert E. Wright, of Rock City, Delmar, New York, to compensate him in full for damages caused to his buildings by arson committed by a paroled fire-bug; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Kenneth Bird, who set this fire, has previously committed arson by setting fire to his mother's home. He was declared sane and committed to the reformatory. He was paroled in about 18 months, on October 8, 1935. On March 16, 1936 he set fire to Wright's buildings.
