STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT to Regulate the Distribution of Public Funds to Hospitals.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

P. L., 1933, c. 178, amended. Chapter 178 of the public laws of 1933 is hereby repealed and the following is enacted in place thereof:

'Condition attached to hospital appropriations. All hospitals in this state which are tax exempt and which receive any public funds appropriated to assist in the care of residents of the state, shall furnish laboratory service to all physicians licensed to practice obstetrics and surgery according to the laws of the state; if equipped for such service.'
