STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

AN ACT Relating to Erection and Equipment of a State Police Barrack in Thomaston.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. r. Establishment of a barrack. There shall be erected and maintained under the supervision of the chief of the state police in the town of Thomaston, in substantially the same location as the present one is located, a state police barrack.
- Sec. 2. Appropriation. For the erection and equipping of said barrack, there shall be appropriated from the state highway police fund the sum of \$13,000.
