STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of Edith Given, of Windsor.

Edith Given; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$33.00 to be paid to Edith Given, of Windsor, as a full and final settlement against the state, for poultry killed by Lauretta Bourassa, a state ward; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Poultry owned by Miss Given was killed by Lauretta Bourassa, a state ward, 8 years of age, in June, 1937.
