## STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED THIRTY-NINE

RESOLVE, in Favor of H. L. Bruen, of Readfield.

H. L. Bruen; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$50.00, to be paid to H. L. Bruen, of Readfield, as a settlement in full for all damages done to his house, occupied by Beatrice Connor and family, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general state funds.

## STATEMENT OF FACTS

This house was hired by the state for occupancy of Mrs. Connor and her children. The family was quite large and Mr. Bruen claims that they were very destructive and that the expense of putting the house in repair after they vacated was far above the amount that he is asking in this resolve.
