RESOLVE, Granting a Bonus to Certain Maine Veterans of the World War.

Certain Maine Veterans of the World War; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, to be paid to the several persons herein listed, the sums set opposite their respective names, amounting in the aggregate to the sum of \$1400, being the amounts recommended by the committee on claims; said amount to be paid from the general funds of the state.
