**RESOLVE, in Favor of Burleigh E. Bean, of Waite.**

**Burleigh E. Bean; state pension. Resolved:** That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Burleigh E. Bean, of Waite, to be paid quarterly from the general funds of the state. Said pension shall begin July 1, 1939, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

### STATEMENT OF FACTS

Because of sickness, Mr. Bean's earnings have been very small during the last 5 years. He is much in need of this pension.
