RESOLVE, in Favor of Otis Jacob Bowen, of Newport.

Otis Jacob Bowen; state pension. Resolved: That a pension of \$12 per month be, and hereby is, granted to Otis Jacob Bowen, of Newport, to be paid from the fund for pensions for soldiers and sailors and their dependents. Said pension shall begin July 1st, 1939, and continue until otherwise provided by the legislature.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

Mr. Bowen is 65 years of age and has been in poor health for a long period of time. In July, 1938, he developed an effusion in the lower left chest, and has been at the Central Maine Sanatorium for examination on 3 different occasions. The lung has not entirely cleared, and he is unable to work a sufficient amount to earn a livelihood. Mr. Bowen is in urgent need of financial assistance. He is the son of Jacob R. Bowen, who served in the Civil War.
