RESOLVE, in Favor of Bates College.

Bates College; compensated. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated, the sum of \$400.55 to be paid to Bates College, in Lewiston, to compensate said College for expenses incurred during the period of supplemental field training of the National Guard of the State of Maine in October and November of 1939; said sum to be paid from the appropriation of the adjutant general's department.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

A period of field training of the National Guard was held the latter part of October and the first part of November, 1939, in Lewiston, Maine, at which time the Field House at Bates College was utilized for the quartering of the troops. This appropriation is to compensate the College for electric current consumed and repairs made necessary by the occupation of the buildings.
