STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY

AN ACT Relating to the Duties of the Treasurer of State.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

- Sec. 1. R. S., c. 125, § 14, amended. Section 14 of chapter 125 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:
- 'Sec. 14. The state treasury. The treasurer of state shall receive an annual salary of three thousand dollars \$3900; he shall receive no other fee, emolument, or perquisite.

The chief clerk in the office of the treasurer of state shall be designated as "Deputy Treasurer of State."

Sec. 2. Duties of treasurer. The treasurer of state shall perform the duties carried out previous to the effective date of this act by the deputy-treasurer.
