STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY

RESOLVE, in Favor of the State Highway Planning Survey.

Emergency preamble. Whereas, there are no funds now available for continuation of the state highway planning survey, and

Whereas, if this resolve does not take effect immediately the program will be delayed for one year, and

Whereas, it is very essential to keep the highway program up to date at this crucial moment, and

Whereas, in the judgment of the legislature these facts create an emergency within the meaning of section 16 of Article XXXI of the constitution of Maine and require the following legislation as immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety; now therefore be it

State highway planning survey; appropriation for. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$20,000 out of the general highway fund for the continuation of work on the state highway planning survey.

Emergency clause. In view of the emergency cited in the preamble, this resolve shall take effect when approved.
