**AN ACT Providing for the Expiration of All Orders of the Governor's  
Council at the End of Its Term.**

---

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows :

**Sec. 1. Orders of governor's council to expire at end of its term.** Chapter 2 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section to be numbered 59-A, and to read as follows :

**'Sec. 59-A. Orders of governor's council to expire at end of its term. Any order issued by the governor and council shall cease to be of any effect or validity at the end of the biennium for which the council passing the order was elected.'**

**Sec. 2. Limitation.** This act shall not have any effect on orders of any councils previous to the present council until the expiration of the term of the present council.
