STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Pedestrians.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Law of the road relating to pedestrians defined. Chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 7-A and to read as follows:

'Sec. 7-A. Pedestrians shall walk on the left side of the road. Pedestrians walking or remaining on the paved portion or travelled part of a roadway or highway shall keep to the left of the center thereof, and shall turn to their left to permit all vehicles passing them in either direction to pass to their right.'
