AN ACT Creating a Bird Sanctuary on Bustin Island.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Bird game preserve established on Bustin Island. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt, pursue, shoot at, or kill any wild bird at any time on Bustin Island in Cumberland county.
