STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Defining "Homes" in re Exemption from Taxation.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 13, § 6, ¶ IX, amended. The last sentence of paragraph IX of section 6 of chapter 13 of the revised statutes, as amended, is hereby further amended to read as follows:

'The word "homes" as used in this paragraph shall mean one single dwelling and the lot it is situated upon owned by the person claiming exemption, or the land which is used by the owner in his occupation as a farmer and the buildings thereon, including his house, or a dwelling partially occupied by the owner and producing a revenue of less than \$200 per year.'

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
