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**AN ACT Relating to Duties of Overseers of the Poor.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 33, additional.** Chapter 33 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto the following section to be numbered 10-A, and to read as follows:

‘Sec. 10-A. Duties may be delegated. Overseers may authorize some person whom they shall designate to perform such of the duties provided in this chapter, as they may determine. Before entering upon the performance of said duties, the person so designated shall be sworn, and shall give bond to the town for the faithful performance thereof, in such sum and with such sureties as the overseers order.’
