STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT to Regulate the Packing of Sardines.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 41, § 79, amended. Section 79 of chapter 41 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by striking out all of said section and inserting in place thereof the following:

'Sec. 79. Cans to be hermetically sealed and enamel lined. On all cans used for packing sardines there shall be used a compound lined gasket, or other adequate gasket as will hermetically seal the container. All cans used for packing sardines shall be enamel lined.'
