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**AN ACT Prohibiting the Construction of State Highways During July and August.**

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Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 28, § 9-A, additional.** Chapter 28 of the revised statutes is hereby amended by adding thereto a new section to be numbered section 9-A, and to read as follows:

**'Sec. 9-A. Construction of state highways during July and August regulated. No state highway shall be constructed or reconstructed during the months of July and August in any year unless they are to be new locations or cut offs which do not interfere with traffic on established ways, or highways to be for military purposes, or unless an emergency exists.'**
