Town of New Portland; reimbursed. Resolved: That the sum of \$3,797.45 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of New Portland, to reimburse it for expenses incurred in the support of Willard Luce and family, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.
