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**RESOLVE, in Favor of the Town of New Portland for Support of Willard  
Luce and Family.**

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**Town of New Portland; reimbursed. Resolved:** That the sum of \$3,797.45 be, and hereby is, appropriated to be paid to the town of New Portland, to reimburse it for expenses incurred in the support of Willard Luce and family, state paupers; said sum to be paid from the general funds of the state.

#### STATEMENT OF FACTS

The town of New Portland paid to the town of Kingfield the sum of \$898.53 for the support of Willard Luce and family for 1932 and 1933. Said town has paid the total sum of \$3,797.45 for Mr. Luce's support for the period from 1932 to 1939.
