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**RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Pierce Pond in Somerset County.**

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**Fishing in Pierce pond; regulated. Resolved:** That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Pierce pond in Bowtown and Pierce Pond townships, county of Somerset, to fly fishing only from the dam at the outlet of said pond to Gull Rock, and to fly fishing and trolling with flies only in Middle and Upper Pierce ponds from Caribou Narrows to head of Upper Lake until July 1st of each year, thereafter, open under general laws.
