RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Kilgore Pond in Bowtown and Pierce Pond Townships.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

Fishing in Kilgore pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation opening Kilgore pond in Bowtown and Pierce Pond townships, county of Somerset, to fishing with bait with a daily bag limit of 4 fish per person per day.
