RESOLVE, for Screening Knight's Pond in Somerset County.

Knight's pond; screening of. Resolved: That there be, and hereby is, appropriated the sum of \$100 to be taken from the appropriation for the maintenance of the department of inland fisheries and game, to aid in the screening of Knight's pond, Square Town township, Somerset county; provided however that said appropriation shall not be available until some responsible person, corporation, or incorporated fish and game club, or the town in which the outlet of the pond above mentioned is situated, or some other town in the county of Somerset, in which said waters are situated shall have agreed to assume all liability for the keeping of said screen at all times free from sticks, leaves and all debris, so that the same will not become clogged and prevent the free running of the water through the same.

STATEMENT OF FACTS

The screening of this pond would permit the stocking of it with fish and thus become an added incentive for tourists in this state.
