RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Alford's Lake and Lermond's Pond.

Fishing in Alford's lake and Lermond's pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game, be and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing to all ice fishing Alford's lake and Lermond's pond, in Hope, county of Knox, except that said waters shall be open to pickerel fishing only, from the time the ice forms in the fall until it goes out in the spring.
