STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

AN ACT Relating to Costs in Contested Cases.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

R. S., c. 75, § 38, amended. Section 38 of chapter 75 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Sec. 38. Costs in contested cases. In all contested cases in the original or appellate court of probate, costs may be allowed to either party, including expert fees not exceeding \$25 per day, to be paid by the other, or to either or both parties, to be paid out of the estate in controversy, as justice requires; and executions may be issued therefor as in courts of common law.'
