## STATE OF MAINE

### IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

### AN ACT Relating to Penalty for Leaving Scene of Accident.

Be it enacted by the People of the State of Maine, as follows:

**R. S., c. 29, § 87, amended.** The 1st paragraph of section 87 of chapter 29 of the revised statutes is hereby amended to read as follows:

'Whoever goes away without stopping and making himself known after causing injury to any person or property, or uses a motor vehicle without authority from its owner, shall be punished by a fine of not more than \$200, or by imprisonment for a term of not more than three **9** months, or by both such fine and imprisonment; and if any person be convicted the second time for a violation of this section, he shall be punished by a fine of not less than \$200 and not more than \$500, or by imprisonment for not more than **11** months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.'
