STATE OF MAINE

IN THE YEAR OF OUR LORD NINETEEN HUNDRED FORTY-ONE

RESOLVE, Regulating Fishing in Puffer's Pond in the Town of Dexter.

Fishing in Puffer's pond, regulated. Resolved: That the commissioner of inland fisheries and game be, and hereby is, directed to issue a rule and regulation closing Puffer's pond in the town of Dexter, county of Penobscot, to all fishing until the ice goes out in the spring of 1942, and closing said pond from then on to all fishing except fly-fishing under the general law.
